

LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS – MANISTIQUE HIGH SCHOOL

J. JOSEPH HERBERT - The amount and number of scholarships awarded depends upon the interest earned in the trust fund. Awarded to a student of good academic standing who is planning to complete a bachelor's degree. Based on financial need. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

SCHOOLCRAFT HOSPITAL AUXILIARY - Two scholarships. \$500.00 each. The scholarships will be awarded to someone going into the medical field such as nursing (practical or registered,) medical technology, x-ray technology, etc. Applications available in the middle/high school office.

MANISTIQUE WOMEN'S CLUB - \$650 - Scholarship chosen on merit and need. Application is available in the middle/school office.

GFWC MANISTIQUE WOMEN'S CLUB/COMFORT INN SCHOLARSHIP - \$650.00 Scholarship chosen on merit and need. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

ROTARY - \$1000 - Scholarship awarded based on academic standing and financial need to a student planning to attend a post-high school educational institution. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

PAUL ESSEX GERO MEMORIAL TRUST - \$100 - Scholarship each year for four years (\$400 total.) Recipients are selected on a point system based on academic standing and varsity athletic awards. **No application is needed.**

PRINE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND – 1 year \$2,000 scholarship - Number of scholarships depends upon the interest earned in the trust fund. The scholarships shall be awarded as an outright grant to provide funds to an academically outstanding senior. Based on financial need. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

HOWARD C. SCHWARTZ - \$1,000 - For a student interested in pursuing a career in secondary education and accepted to an accredited college or university. The student should have made a positive contribution to his/her school and community. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

KRISTINA DERBER-SCHWARTZ SCHOLARSHIP - \$2,000 - This scholarship shall be granted to that graduating senior with a **2.99 or lower G.P.A.**, who has been most conscientious in his/her work, and who has made a positive contribution to Manistique High School. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

LIMESTONE FEDERAL CREDIT UNION SCHOLARSHIP - \$1,000 (\$500 per semester) - Student or their family must be a credit union member for at least 6 months. 250-500 word essay required and pursuing a career in accounting, business or education. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

WILLARD J. & ELEANOR B. BALL SCHOLARSHIP - \$200 - This scholarship uses the same criteria as the Manistique Area Schools Foundation Scholarship. Selection will be made by the M.A.S. Foundation selection committee. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

MANISTIQUE AREA SCHOOLS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP - \$2,000 - Scholarship based on academic standing and participation in school and community activities. Number of scholarships depends upon interest earned by the foundation. Applications are available in the middle/high school office.

Michigan State University Lisa M. Weber Medical Memorial Scholarship: \$500.00 non-renewable. For a Manistique high school student with an acceptance letter from Michigan State University. The Lisa M. Weber scholarship has been established for a student who has been accepted at Michigan State University and must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and be enrolled full-time in a pre-medicine, nursing, medical technology or other health care curriculum. Application is available in the Manistique High School Office. Selection will be made by the MAS selection committee.

WOMEN OF THE MOOSE MEDICAL FIELD SCHOLARSHIP - \$100 – Application is available in the middle/high school office.

FYVIE-WATERS MEDICAL SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 - Scholarship for a student interested in the medical field. Scholarship is to be awarded on a merit basis. Application is available in middle/high school office.

SCHOOLCRAFT COUNTY U.P. WHITETAIL SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 renewable - For a Manistique High School senior with a 3.0 or better G.P.A. who has participated in at least one extra-curricular activity each year and plans to study conservation, wildlife biology, or forestry . Application is available in the middle/high school office.

ACADEMIC BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 non-renewable - This is a Merit Based Premier Scholarship. Applications will only be accepted from those seniors who are third year award recipients of the Academic Booster Club. The recipient of this scholarship must be enrolled full-time. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

MHS ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB EMERALD SCHOLARSHIPS - Two - \$1000 scholarships to be awarded. One to a male athlete and one to a female athlete. 1) 2.5 Cumulative GPA. 2) Must have received a minimum of 8 athletic letters over their high school career. 3) Must complete a 300-500 word essay. 4) Students must be planning to attend a post-high school educational institution. Applications are available in the middle/high school office.

LAURA M. WEHNER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - The Laura M. Wehner Memorial Scholarship has been established to provide non-renewable (\$500 minimum) scholarships to honors graduates of Manistique High School. Students must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and be enrolled in a pre-medicine, nursing, medical technology or other health care curriculum at an accredited college or university. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

MANISTIQUE FEDERAL CREDIT UNION SCHOLARSHIP- \$1,000 (\$500 per semester) - Student must be a credit union member in good standing for at least 6 months. Essay required and field of study must be financially related. Leadership skills & service/volunteerism will be a consideration. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

THE EARL C. WILLIAMSON SCHOLARSHIP- \$600. Requires a 3.0 or higher GPA. Student must be entering science or chemistry field. Application is available in middle/high school office.

STATE SAVINGS BANK SCHOLARSHIP – 1,000 per year for up to four continuous years of college. Requires a 3.00 or higher GPA. The recipient or the recipient’s family does not have to be customers of the State Savings Bank. The successful candidate must be attending a community college or university as a full-time student. Payment is made in August of each year upon proof of enrollment in a post-secondary program. Payment will be made by a check payable to the student and the college/university. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

Fraternal Order of Police Scholarship - \$500. Must have a 3.0 or higher GPA. Essay required and must be majoring in a criminal justice field. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

AFSCME Local 1196 Scholarship - \$500. Student’s parent/guardian must be a member in good standing of AFSCME Local 1196 (Schoolcraft Memorial Hospital). Must have 2.0 or higher GPA. Application is available in the middle/high school office.

Please note: Students must have completed at least three semesters at Manistique High School by graduation in order to be eligible to apply for local scholarships. Transfer students with less than three semesters at Manistique High School will maintain a class ranking and be eligible for possible designation as an honor student, receiving an honor cord, but these transferring students will be excluded from participation in the following graduation honors: valedictorian and salutatorian designation, local scholarships, and top ten designations.
